Identification Is Your Pets Ticket Home

Studies have shown that almost half a million stray cats are brought to shelters every year. Unfortunately for both people and animals, only a tiny percentage of these cats are ever returned to their homes.

Don't take a chance on losing your cat forever. All cats need identification even if they never go outside. Options include ID tags, microchips and tattoos. Identification should include your name, address and phone numbers (day and evening) and your pet's name. You may want to attach the identification on a collar that has a short piece of elastic sewn in – this will allow it to stretch and let your cat escape if caught on a tree limb or fence.
